Class 1 have described the characters, made collages of the beanstalk and planted our own beans to watch grow over the next few weeks!

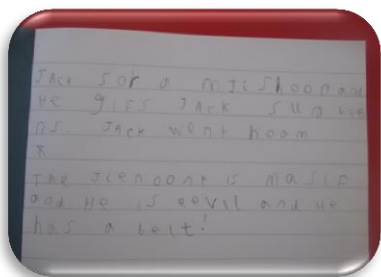


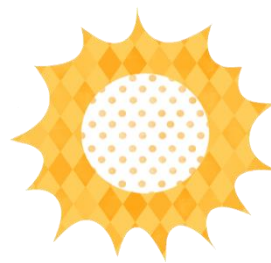
Table Tennis and Art inspired by David Hockney
